(PAC members are financially responsible for their travel to the in-person meeting.)
- Serve as a liaison to the Division of Student Life and Parent & Family Programs with any trending parent concerns so that we can focus our programs and resources to meet the current needs of all UA families.

- Participate in, represent the PAC, and facilitate any Affinity Group or Regional Meet Ups that you are relevant for you/your student.
- Promote "staying connected" with and represent the University among families of current and prospective UA students in your respective region.
- Stay informed and up-to-date of campus resources and share information about those with other UA families.
- Support the University by making an annual financial contribution to the Capstone Family Fund at an amount that is comfortable for your family's situation.
- Volunteer with current programs and outreach (communication efforts, Family Weekend, Parent & Family Orientation, etc.); be a "go-to" parent for virtual Parent & Family activities.
- Serve as a resource to other families (Parent & Family Programs may refer families to PAC members for insight and guidance).
